The Food Pantry always welcomes new clients. We provide food and basic hygiene products to those lacking consistent resources for those items. We will help everyone we are able to, free of charge and with complete privacy. We understand that after bills, rent and unexpected financial troubles, many people are left with very little money, if any, for food. Our mission is to help people through those times.

How to Register: Once we confirm you are a Waukesha County resident, we look at your current income and living situation to determine the best way to serve you now and in the future.

Please provide:

- A current driver's license or a Social Security card* for every household member
- Current proof of address such as a bill, bank statement or other similar piece of official mail for every adult household member
- Information about your current source of income (wages, unemployment, or any other income)
- Clients may use the pantry once every 14 days.

*If your driver's license does not list your current address, please bring your license plus two pieces of mail. If you do not have Social Security cards for each member of the family, provide alternative IDs, such as an insurance card, Forward Care information or other documentation.

How to register:

At your first visit you will be asked to provide basic information on your household including: contact information, household size and demographic information on each member. You will also be asked to provide verification of address and identity for each member of the household. **Please bring the following items with you on your first visit:**

- Current Utility Bill (or other piece of official mail) that has your Waukesha County address on it.
- Photo ID for head of household.
- Proof of ID for each member such as: Photo ID, Insurance Card, Social Security Card, Medical Card, Immunization Card or other appropriate form of proof.

After you have completed the initial registration you will need to bring only a photo ID upon each visit. Periodically The Salvation Army food pantry will update your information and may request updated verification of address and identity.

- **Farmer's Market Vouchers** for Waukesha County seniors (60 and up) who meet income requirements.
- **Home delivered meals** are available to homebound persons age 60 and older and their spouse, regardless of their age. The person must be a resident of Waukesha County, unable to prepare adequate nutritious meals, and unable to attend a senior dining center. Meals are delivered between 11:00 am and 1:00 pm.
