A Busy Doctor

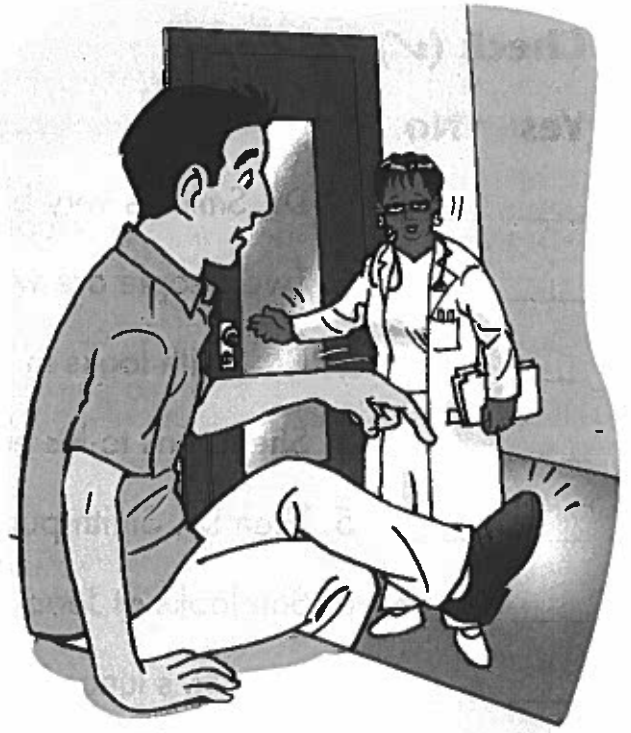
Dr. Smith is very busy today.

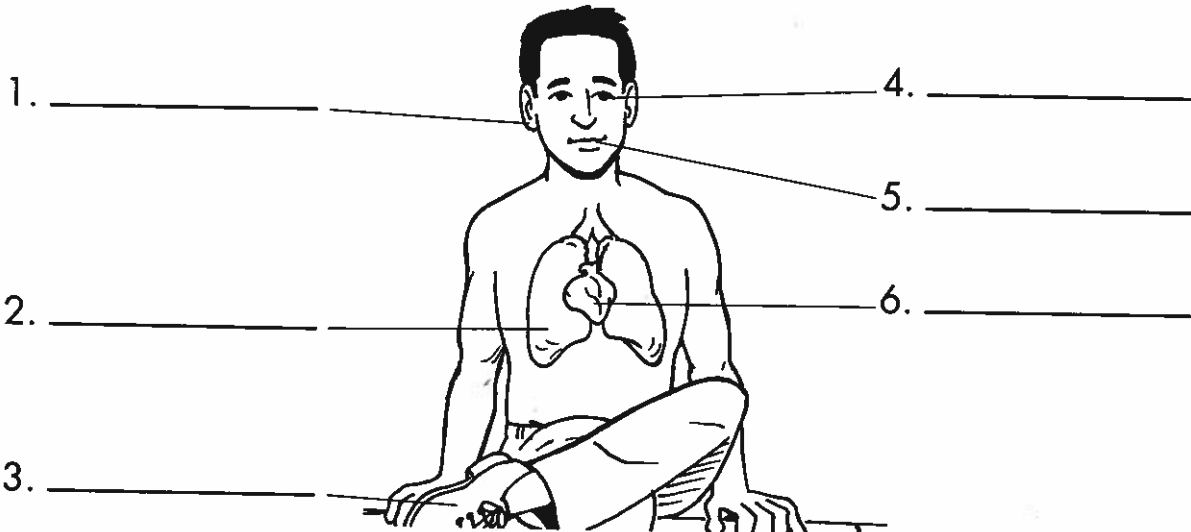
