### **Grammar Notes**

### THERE IS / THERE ARE

When "there" begins a sentence, it has no meaning. It is called an "empty subject." We can use "there" and the Be verb to describe the **amount** and **location** of an object.

Is "there" singular or plural? It depends on the object (the noun that follows the Be verb).

### **A. Positive Sentences**

Sentences beginning with "there" follow specific patterns in English. We use "there is" when the object noun is singular (one) and "there are" when it is plural (two or more).

Туре	Pattern	Examples	
Singular Noun	There + is + a + noun + preposition + the + noun.	<ul> <li>There is a cat on the bed.</li> <li>There is a girl in the photo.</li> <li>There is a tree in the front yard.</li> </ul>	
Plural Noun	There + are (+ quantifier) + noun + preposition + the + noun.	<ul> <li>There are apples in the fridge.</li> <li>There are two pillows on the bed.</li> <li>There are many people at the gym.</li> </ul>	





#### A. Positive Sentences cont.

### Note #1

Did you notice the articles in the example sentences? We use **a** or **an** after Be and **the** after the preposition.

- There is **a** cat on **the** bed.
- There is **a** clock on **the** nightstand.
- There is an orange in the bowl.

#### Note #2

Some nouns in English are uncountable. For example, we can't count snow, rain, water, or milk. Use "there is" with these non-count nouns even if you use a quantifier like "some" or "a lot of."

- There is water in the bathtub.
- There is some snow on the trees.
- There is a lot of rice on the plate.

#### Note #3

It is common to **shorten** "there is" to "there's" (especially when speaking). We can **never** shorten "there are" to "there're" because it is too difficult to pronounce "there're"!

- ✓ There's a dog in the park.
- × There're two dogs in the park.

### Note #4

Some sentences don't include "preposition + the + noun." This happens when the location is obvious or not important.

- There is a good explanation.
- There is some new information.
- There are many children here today.

### **Memory Trick**

Almost every sentence with "there is" and "there are" needs an **-s!** If there is no -s at the end of the object noun, use "is." If there is an -s at the end of the noun, use "are."

- There is a plate in the cabinet.
- There is milk in the fridge.
- There are pens in my bag.



### **B. Negative Sentences**

Negative sentences starting with "there" usually take a **plural** verb and a **plural** object noun. We can use **aren't + any** or **are + no** with no difference in meaning.

Туре	Pattern	Examples
Negative Verb	There + <b>aren't</b> + <b>any</b> + plural noun + preposition + the + noun.	<ul> <li>There aren't any books on the table.</li> <li>There aren't any leaves in the yard.</li> <li>There aren't any good movies in the theater.</li> </ul>
Negative Noun	There + <b>are</b> + <b>no</b> + plural noun + preposition + the + noun.	<ul> <li>There are no children at the park.</li> <li>There are no blankets on the bed.</li> <li>There are no rules for the game.</li> </ul>

### Note #5

It is more common for negative sentences starting with "there" to take a plural verb and object noun, but a singular verb and object noun are also possible.

- There **isn't** any **reason** to keep studying.
- There **is** no **snow** on the ground.



### **C. Questions**

Yes/no questions with "there" begin with the Be verb. This is the normal pattern for simple present tense questions with Be. Short answers include "Yes, there is/are" and "No, there isn't/aren't."

Туре	Pattern	Questions	Answers
	<b>Is</b> there a <b>textbook</b> on the desk?	<ul><li>Yes, there is.</li><li>No, there isn't.</li></ul>	
Singular Noun & Non-Count Noun	Is + there + a + noun + preposition + the + noun?	<b>Is</b> there a <b>boy</b> on the playground?	<ul><li>Yes, there is.</li><li>No, there isn't.</li></ul>
		<b>Is</b> there <b>sand</b> on the beach?	<ul><li>Yes, there is.</li><li>No, there isn't.</li></ul>
		<b>Are</b> there <b>errors</b> in my essay?	<ul><li>Yes, there are.</li><li>No, there aren't.</li></ul>
Plural Noun	Are + there (+ any) + noun + preposition + the + noun?	<b>Are</b> there any <b>cookies</b> in the cabinet?	<ul><li>Yes, there are.</li><li>No, there aren't.</li></ul>
		<b>Are</b> there any good <b>shows</b> on TV?	<ul><li>Yes, there are.</li><li>No, there aren't.</li></ul>



### **D. Present & Past Tenses**

We use "there is" and "there are" to describe scenes in the simple present tense. To describe a scene in the simple past tense, we can use "there was" and "there were."

	Simple Present	Simple Past
Verb Form	is / are	was / were
Singular Noun	There <b>is</b> a mess in the kitchen today.	There <b>was</b> a mess in the kitchen yesterday.
& Non-Count	There <b>isn't</b> any ice on the road.	There <b>wasn't</b> any ice on the road.
Noun	<b>Is</b> there an e-reader on the desk?	<b>Was</b> there an e-reader on the desk?
	There <b>are</b> many people on the bus today.	There <b>were</b> many people on the bus yesterday.
Plural Noun	There <b>aren't</b> any books on the floor.	There <b>weren't</b> any books on the floor.
	<b>Are</b> there any dogs at the park?	<b>Were</b> there any dogs at the park?



### E. Nouns in a Series

When "there + Be" is followed by more than one noun object, the normal rules do not apply. We would expect that two or more nouns would take a plural verb, but this does not happen. It all depends on the **first noun** in the series. The Be verb agrees with that first noun only.

#	Rule	Examples	
1	When the first noun in a series is singular, use "there is."	<ul> <li>There is a book and an apple in my backpack.</li> <li>There is a dog and two cats in your yard.</li> <li>There is an orange, a banana, and a plum in the bowl.</li> </ul>	
2	When the first noun in a series is plural, use "there are."	<ul> <li>There are jackets and shoes in the closet.</li> <li>There are 15 boys and 11 girls in my class.</li> <li>There are many pens and a pencil on the desk.</li> </ul>	
3	When the first noun in a series is uncountable, use "there is."	<ul> <li>There is ice and rocks on the road.</li> <li>There is juice, milk, and water in the fridge.</li> <li>There is some sugar and a lot of butter in these cookies.</li> </ul>







# **Answer Key**

#### **LESSON DESCRIPTION:**

### **Grammar Notes**

Before you begin, ask your students if they know how to determine whether a verb following "there" is singular or plural. Then try to elicit the pattern for singular, plural, and uncountable nouns.

Note that the rules for there is/there are with a series of nouns are the most generally accepted rules. However, not all grammar guides agree.
